SR 0611, Section ERM Emergency Rock Slope Mitigation Project Delaware Water Gap Borough, Monroe County, PA Phase I Project Online Public Meeting

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Engineering District 5-0 (PennDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration have begun planning and design work for the stabilization of the rock slope along the west side of SR 0611 in Delaware Water Gap Borough, Monroe County, Pennsylvania. This is the Phase I project. The scope of Phase I consists only of scaling to remove loose rock throughout project area within PennDOT's right-of-way. SR 0611 is currently closed to traffic due to the public health and safety concerns of the unstable rock slope along the roadway. The proposed project will reopen SR 0611 for safe and efficient transportation for the traveling public.
