NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by Delaware Water Gap Borough, Monroe County, 49 Main Street, Delaware Water Gap, PA 18327 for the DELAWARE WATER GAP BOROUGH PAVING PROJECT. Bids will be submitted and updated online via the PennBid™ Program until 1:00 PM, July 19, 2023. Bids will be publicly read at the Council workshop meeting at approximately 7:00 PM.

All documents and solicitation details are available at no cost at PennBid™ - www.ebidexchange.com/pennbid. Click on the "Solicitations" then "View" tabs.

Bids must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond issued by a Surety licensed to conduct business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the amount of at least 10 percent (10%) of the total bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for a Satisfactory Performance and Payment Bond and Labor and Material Bond in an amount of 100% of the contract amount. A Certificate of Insurance, showing proof of Workers Compensation Coverage, must also be submitted.

The project will require minimum wages and salaries to meet the PA Prevailing Wage requirements. The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap.

Award of the Contract will be to the lowest responsible bidder, but the Owner reserves the unqualified right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities permitted by law. Bids may be held by the Borough for a period of 60 days from the date of Bid opening for the purpose of reviewing Bids and investigating qualifications of bidders prior to awarding Contract. The Borough intends to award the contract at a Council meeting on August 7, 2023.

Prospective bidders are invited to attend a Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference on Monday, July 10, 2023, at 9:00 AM, at Borough Hall. All questions concerning the bid documents or the project in general should be submitted to the Engineer via PennBid no later than 4:30 PM, July 13, 2023.
